Benefits and commitments:

Felm

- providing a supervisor for the intern, who will have a starters session and evaluation sessions with him/her
- providing the tasks and instructions for the intern
- advising the applicant with visa-procedures
- accommodation at a Guest house within 3 kilometres distance of the working place with a shared bathroom, toilet and shared kitchen facilities
- draft program for the intern period
- transportation: Kathmandu airport - agreed lodgings –airport
- introducing the intern to Felm's / partners' other work at the area
- feedback session at Felm Helsinki offices
