Benefits and commitments: Felm

- providing the tasks, materials and instructions for the Felm Volunteer
- advising the applicant with visa-procedures and providing Felm Volunteer visa-invitation letter
- providing a personal tutor and a draft program for the Felm Volunteer period (incl. tutor discussions: starters session, mid-term discussion and evaluation session)
- transportation Tel Aviv Ben Gurion airport – agreed lodgings – Tel Aviv airport (Felm Volunteer arrives independently to and from the center using a shared sherut –taxi / costs are covered by the center)
- accommodation at Felm center (room, in the hall toilet, bathroom, kitchen facilities, water and electricity)
