The Church is active and growing and currently has almost 5,000 members. Church has wide diakonia work to strengthen families, including day care centers, scholarship program, assist for elderly people and a shelter for pregnant women and their babies. The Home of Grace in Bangkok provides help for pregnant women living in difficult circumstances.</p> <p>Home of Grace (HG) is a temporary shelter for women who face difficulties due to their pregnancy. They can live at HG before and/or a while after the baby is born at no charge. In HG we believe, that even though circumstances may be difficult, there is hope of a good future for both the mother and the child. The women get counseling and receive information about different options for them including raising their child by themselves, use of foster families and adoption. Activities include handicrafts, cooking, cleaning, Bible and English lessons, learning life skills and practicing in the coffeeshop of HG.</p>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Work together with Home of Grace staff to provide a safe and caring environment for mothers-to-be, new mothers and babies. - Arrange activities for mothers to help them relax and empower them as well as help them get new skills and trust to the good future. - Encourage mothers to take care of their babies. - Be a good, mature role model for young mothers. - Help to improve activities in the Carden Cafee of Home of Grace. <p>-Possibly help in a day care center by arranging activities and teaching English for children in Bangkok / a student home in country side as part of the period.</p> <p>-Confidence in living in Home of Grace, possibly a period in a student home.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Participate in daily life at Home of Grace, having day and night shifts as needed. Night time alone at duty, a staff member lives nearby. - Assist and guide mothers taking care of babies. - Arrange activities, like teaching English and life skills, baking, handicrafts etc. according to volunteer own skills. - Assist baking and working at Garden Cafee. - Participate in the church activities like Sunday service as part of the work at Home of Grace. - Possibly arrange activities and teach English for children in a day care center in Bangkok / student home in country side.

Competence / Qualifications / Language requirements:

- meet the requirements of the Felm Volunteer program
- a mature person with skills and competence in living in a different culture context, being a responsible adult
- able to communicate without common language as translation provided only in scheduled times
- minimum language requirement: good written and spoken English
- beneficial/preferred: knowledge of thai language, experience working with mothers and babies, children and youth

Benefits and commitments: Felm and partner ELCT

- providing the tasks, materials and instructions for the Felm Volunteer
- advising the applicant with visa-procedures and providing Felm Volunteer visa-invitation letter
- providing a personal tutor and a draft program for the Felm Volunteer period (incl. tutor discussions: starters session, mid-term discussion and evaluation session)
- transportation: Suwarnabhumi airport – Home of Grace –Suwarnabhumi airport + transportation related to FELM Volunteer tasks
- accommodation at Home of Grace with a western toilet, bathroom, kitchen facilities, water and electricity, WIFI
- introducing the Felm Volunteer to Felm's / partners other work at the area
